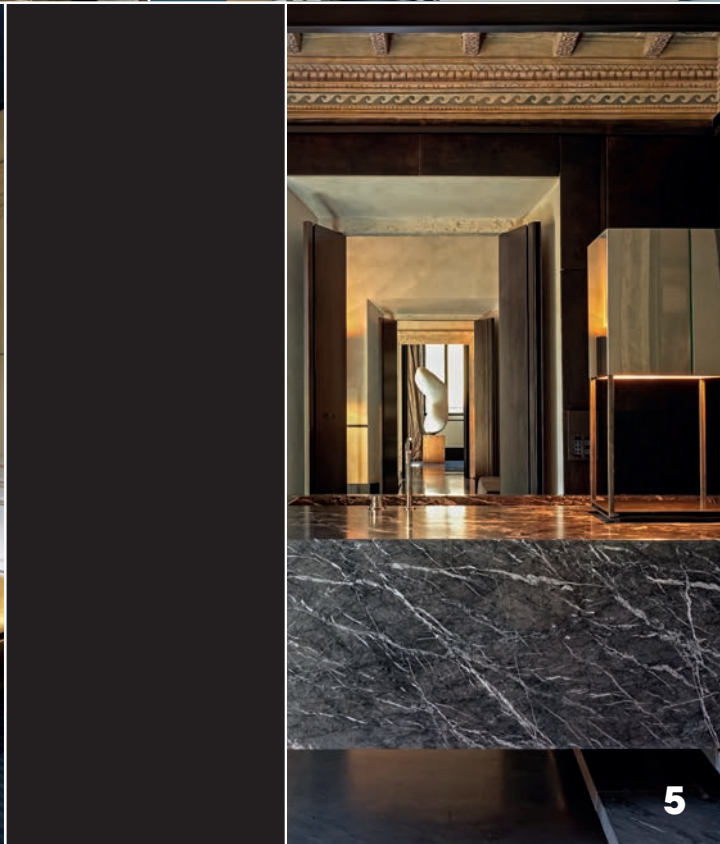
Lazzarini and Pickering Architetti was founded in Rome, Italy in 1982 by Claudio Lazzarini and Carl Pickering.
